- \* NAMA (Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions)
- This Forum is hosted to discuss a direction for practices to strengthen capabilities of developing countries including distribution of new and renewable energy after the 1st Forum (Jun. 17~18, 2010).
- \* The result of discussions undertaken by the steering committee (Mar. 2010) of the 1st C2GMF(Cooperative Green Growth Modeling Forum) indicates that developing countries showed the highest interest in issues related to energy.
